# HOME ECONOMICS CLASS DURING THEIR PRACTICAL PREPARATION OF MEALS.



- The challenge facing this practical part of it is storage. They need storage refrigerator to preserve their delicate food such as milk, meat e.t.c. the cost of the refrigerator is US\$3125.

The cost of this installation needed is worth US\$12000. If this is done, it will help AFINNET partly become self reliant through selling furniture products.

# AFINNET CARPENTRY TOOLS



- This year 2012, we have 12 carpentry students whom we hope to graduate but we usually give out a tool box to each student. A tool box is at a cost of US\$65 and in total for the 12 we need US\$780.

# TAILORING CLASS DURING THEIR PRACTICALS.



- Each machine is shared by two to four students. The number of students is greater than the number of the sewing machines we have. We have 82 students out of 35 sewing machines in use. The cost of each machine is US\$115 whereas during the graduation ceremony, it is our norm to send each student with a sewing machine

# GRADUATION FOR 2011



- As it has been our custom of giving out sewing machines, about 80 students received their sewing machines as you can see some posing in these photos together with their guardians.
- In this year's graduation(2012) we need 82 sewing machines to give out to students. This in total requires us US\$9225

# OTHER NEEDS FOR AFINNET TAILORING DEPARTMENT.



- For practical purposes for our students we need the following items:  
Practical rolls of papers, rolls of cloth, needles, threads, ceasars, buttons and zips. The total cost needed is worth US\$1500



# SOME OF AFINNET COMPUTER STUDENTS



- The computer classes are often interrupted by power blackouts. We need to install an inverter system worth US\$2500
- Alternatively we may buy a generator worth US\$1650

# AFINNET COMPUTER LAB OTHER NEEDS.



- Currently we have 14 computers. We need some more 6 computers to make a number of 20 for two rooms.
- Each computer costs US\$625 making a total US\$3750 for 6 computers.



# THE STATE OF AFINNET KITCHEN



- The kitchen is in a bad state. We need to reconstruct it using bricks, sand and cement. This requires US\$3500

# AFINNET WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM



- This water supply costs AFINNET not less than US\$800 per year for our students consumption.
- This piped water is supplied by Mityana Town Council.

# INSIDE AFINNET GIRLS HOSTEL



- AFINNET girl students in their bed room. Most of their beds lack mosquito nets which is at the cost of US\$10 each. They are useful in preventing malaria which is rampant here in Uganda.



# OUTSIDE AFINNET GIRLS HOSTEL



- We need outside finishing with painting together with a verandar. This will require US\$1600.

## AFINNET STUDENTS TOGETHER WITH INSTRUCTORS AND RESIDENT DIRECTOR POSING IN FRONT OF ADMINISTRATION BLOCK



- We have a Principal, two instructors for tailoring, One instructor for home economics, two instructors in carpentry, One instructor in computer studies making a total of 6 instructors plus a cook and night watchman.
- We need US\$6000 per year for only wages and salaries for all our AFINNETworkers.

# AFINNET STUDENTS INFRONT OF ADMINISTRATION BLOCK



- To avoid students redundancy after their classes, we need to create a recreation centre equipped with sports items like balls, cricket balls. This requires us US\$800
